Good reasons to go to an ER:

- Loss of consciousness
- Signs of a heart attack
- Severe shortness of breath
- Bleeding that does not stop after applied pressure for 10 minutes
- Poisoning
- Severe worsening reaction to an insect bite, sting, medication, especially if breathing is difficult
- Major injury, such as head trauma
- Unexplained stupor, drowsiness or disorientation
- Coughing up or vomiting blood
- Severe or persistent vomiting

If you need immediate attention but your symptoms are not severe or life threatening, you may want to visit an Urgent Clinic.

Minor reasons may be treated at the Student Health Center, your Primary Care Physician or you may contact Teledoc.
